WHEREAS, the late Richard Peacock, former Secretary of the Virginia Association of Railway Patrons (VARP), was an ardent supporter and advocate who worked indefatigably to promote passenger rail service in the Northern Virginia area; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Peacock diligently worked to inaugurate the Virginia Railway Express (VRE) commuter rail system in our area and was instrumental in securing extended Amtrak train service to Lynchburg and Roanoke, Virginia, the latter which is due to begin late in 2017; and

WHEREAS, as a response to the deaths of several trespassers crossing the tracks in the Burke area, Mr. Peacock was able to secure construction of a safety fence at the Burke VRE/Amtrak station; and

WHEREAS, over the years, Mr. Peacock worked tirelessly, contacting local legislators and City officials to secure better signage at rail passenger stations, and regularly updated them on passenger rail issues; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Peacock was a frequent contributor of letters and information to our local newspaper editors, always promoting rail passenger topics, and was instrumental in successfully securing the return of steam trains to the Manassas area at the Railroad Festival.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Harry J. Parrish II, Mayor of the City of Manassas on behalf of the Manassas City Council hereby publicly commend and recognize posthumously the late

for his dedication, devoted service, and passionate work on behalf of securing successful passenger rail service to Northern Virginia that has had such a positive impact on our area.
